Leave the empty cup in the bowl on the side as you return to your seat.

Anyone who prefers not to commune, is still welcome to come up for a blessing. If you, due to mobility issues, would prefer to receive communion in your seat, please let one of the ushers know, and Pastor will bring communion to you.
